PROCEEDINGS OF THE CENTRAL EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETING
HELD AT **VARANASI** on Monday the 10th of May 2010.

The well attended meeting was presided over by the Central Vice President Com.M.P.MISHRA, since our Central President's train was running late by 16 hrs. In his address he explained about the Section Controllers' Mass CL and WR/CR Motormen's Agitation at Mumbai. He also explained painfully the negative attitude of the HRD in Railway Board. He emphasized that the bureaucracy will understand the language of AGITATION only.

Then he called for the reports of the General Secretaries. Eleven General Secretaries placed their Written/Oral reports pertaining to their activities and action plan before the house, including the RTI reply, implementation of MACP, Financial Position and Membership Drive etc.,

The Secretary General placed his written report wherein he apologized for having delivered a misleading information before the house in CEC Meeting at NGP and explained in detail about the disingenuous information received from the Railway Board (full text available in www.aisma.in). He further explained the CBGM of AIREC, position of Running Allowance Case etc., He was vociferous in the expectation of the cadre to eliminate the Grade Pay of Rs.2800/- as initial grade pay for Station Masters through a Khasi Pack. The Central Secretary-Finance could not attend the meeting due to his personal intricacy. After threadbare discussions the SG's report was passed.

Then the Secretary General of AIREC Com.C.M.Singh addressed the members after he was elected in the General Body Meeting held at Varanasi on 09th May 2010. He recalled his association with the erstwhile leaders such as R.N.Ghosh, A.K.Roy Chowdry, Sivan Pillai, M.Ramani etc., He expressed his special appreciation for calling the CECM in synchronization with the AIREC-CBCM, and assured his best in solving the problems of Station Masters.

The house adjourned for Lunch and for the election of Zonal office bearers of North Eastern Railway. Com.Prabhakar Pandey SM/Gonda/LJH (09451854103) was elected as General Secretary of NER.

The Post lunch session started with the poetical address on SMs carrier by Com.Ramdas Prasad, Retd SM.

During the organisational Hour the president called all the Zones to express their view and proposals on the Action programme. All the zones attended narrated their Zonal activities, strategies and proposed their action programme. After serious deliberations with all the General Secretaries a consensus was reached by the House and an Action Plan charted out as '**KHASI PACT**' i.e.

“Mass Rally at NDLS on 14th July 2010, commencing from NDLS Railway Station to Parliament and to sit for 48 Hrs HUNGER FAST, in front of Hon’ble Minister for Railway’s Official Residence at NDLS”.

Accordingly to execute the programme successfully a Central Action Committee was formed under the Chairmanship of Com.R.BALASUBRAMANIAN (09443425975) and one nominee from each Zone. To conduct the programme successfully, the fund allocated for ‘Safety Seminar’ as decided in the NGP CECM is to be utilised and all the Zones who have not remitted the funds ie Rs.10 000 per Zone are to remit the same immediately.

GS/NCR informed the house that the 44th CBGM will be conducted in Agra on 22nd and 23rd October 2010 and the Divisional Quota for the BGM was fixed as Rs.4000/- (Details will be published in SAMACHAR)

During the organizational Hour few SMs raised the issue of improper implementation of MACPS, especially for the Inter Divisional Transferees, Inter Departmental Transferees etc., In this regard the house decided to submit a detailed memorandum before the newly constituted “**Joint Committee to examine the anomalies pertaining to MACPS**” by **The Joint Secretary (Estt), DoP&T, as Chairman.**

After arriving at the aforesaid decision, our ex-President and the newly elected working President of AIREC, Com.U.S.Singh addressed the members and enlightened the house on the 14 point charter of Demands, the Indefinite Fast at Boat Club/NDLS, Mass Rally etc. for achieving the minimum grade of Rs.5000-8000. He specifically narrated the sacrifice done to get the first cadre Restructuring, Terry Cotton Uniform etc. He explained in detail about the Running Allowance and its advantage, the Safety Allowance and the recurring benefits of all these etc., He expressed his happiness about the presence of too many youngsters in the House and wished that with this young and energetic members the demands to be translated into a fruitful result in the near future and he assured to continue to spare himself for this Association.

The meeting concluded with the single agenda **to gear up the cadre on war footing for the proposed action programmes from 14th July 2010 at NDLS.**

The newly elected General Secretary/NER, Com Prabhakar Pandey delivered Vote of THANKS.
