**Subject: Posting of Station Superintendents of Supervisory and train passing duties.**

Reference Ministry of Railway's letter No.86/H/5/22 dated 06.11.1986 prescribing the medical classification of A-two for both supervisory and non-supervisory Station Superintendents in scale Rs.700-900/- (RS)/Rs.2000-3200/- (RS).

2. With reference thereto, the Ministry of Railways have decided that posting in supervisory posts of Station Superintendents should normally be done on the basis of seniority. In other words, as far as possible while senior persons selected as Station Superintendents will be assigned supervisory duties, the juniors will be posted on train passing duties.
3. As regards the existing regular incumbents who might have passed the B-one medical classification, they need not be subjected to re-examination in A-two only on account of the higher medical classification now prescribed. They will continue to work in Supervisory Category or in other similar posts as deemed fit by the Railway Administrations.
